After consultation with London Borough of Hounslow it has been agreed that the new food recycling units will be delivered to the Dock during the week commencing Monday 12<sup>th</sup> March. Soon after this you will all receive your own individual caddie boxes and information leaflets explaining exactly what food waste can be put in the units. All the waste must be in

bio-degradable bags, not plastic bags. There will be 16 of these food waste recycling units situated around the Dock, near to existing recycling areas. This is a large investment and undertaking by the LBH, so we are keen to support the initiative.

## Asbestos



We would like to remind all residents on the Dock about the presence of asbestos in the majority of flats. Unless your property has had a full asbestos removal conducted, by a specialised company, **THERE WILL BE ASBESTOS IN YOUR HOME**. The pictures above show how seriously we take issue. These pictures show a property in Numa Court having the asbestos removed from the bathroom, prior to refurbishment earlier this week. As you will see all the area was sealed in plastic, and when they had finished the workers went through a decontamination unit (central photo). The “In property asbestos guidelines” for Brentford Dock are available from the office. If it is left undisturbed, the asbestos in its self does not present a problem.

## Clubroom Vacuum Cleaner



A small vacuum cleaner has been bought for use in the Residents’ Clubroom, for people hiring the hall. This will enable them to clean the room after use so that the next people using the room find it clean and ready to use. The Security Guards will show you where the vacuum is kept and will record the condition of the rooms.
