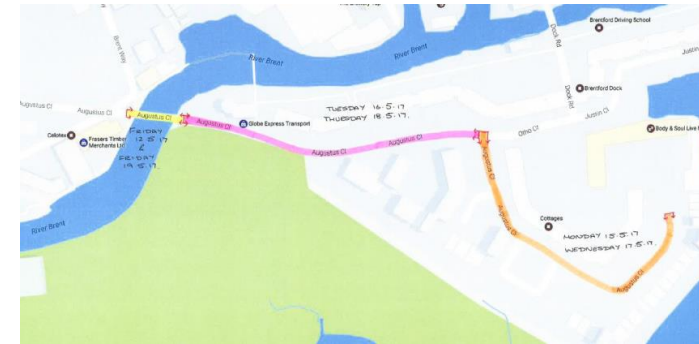

IMPORTANT: Augustus Close Bridge and Resurfacing Works



You should have received (or will do shortly) a letter from LBH Highways informing us of the resurfacing works that are going to be done in Augustus Close. These works will be coordinated with the opening of the bridge on Friday 19th May.

The work will be phased over 5 days starting on Monday 15th at the Marina end of Augustus and finishing with the bridge itself. There are 2 processes involved. First the existing surface will be removed and the new surface laid on top. This will be unavoidably noisy and will cause a certain amount of inconvenience so we anticipate that a degree of patience will be needed during this time.

The road will be accessible every evening/night between 5pm and 7.30am.

We understand that the contractor will be as flexible as possible regarding access, but there will be occasions when the roads will be closed. You are advised not to drive over newly laid hot tarmac as it will damage your tyres. The full program of works is expected as follows:

Marina end of Augustus Close to Romulus Court;

Monday 15th surface removal - Wednesday 17th resurfacing.

Romulus Court to Augustus Close bridge;

Tuesday 16th surface removal – Thursday 18th resurfacing.
Augustus Close Bridge completion and re-opening 19th May

Once Augustus Close and the bridge is re-opened, Hounslow Highways will make repairs to Dock Road. LBH also plan to replace the canal footbridge (by the Clubroom) before the end of 2017.
